


To add your GRM Email account to your Android device, you will need to locate the “Email” app. It will look similar to the image below.



Once the App is opened, please **enter your full GRM email address and your password**. Then click **“Manual Setup”**



You will then be asked what type of account you are using. Please select “POP3”




