•Applicants must:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Be accepted by an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational technical school.
- Have at least a "C" grade point average (GPA).
- Have a parent or legal guardian who is an active GRM Networks member in good standing at the application deadline.

•Immediate family of GRM Networks employees or board members are not eligible. Immediate family members are: parents, siblings, children, spouse, grandchildren or the same immediate family members of a spouse.

•Scholarship winners will be selected by a committee of GRM Networks board members.

•Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and are not renewable.

•Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender or disability.

•Winners will forfeit their scholarship if an unofficial transcript showing a minimum 2.0 grade point average is not received by GRM Networks within 60 days of the end of their first semester of post-high school education. The unofficial transcript can be sent to the address above or emailed to adavison@corp.grm.net.

•Scholarships will be paid directly to the student in the form of a check after the first semester transcript is received.

•GRM Networks will award up to \$5,500 in scholarships, with awards ranging from \$500 to \$1,500.
